State and federal laws and our insurance company limit those who can operate machinery, drive, be in a walk-in cooler or freezer or to handle some kitchen utensils. If you are under 21, and will be required to drive a Windermere vehicle, or your own vehicle on behalf of Windermere, then you must be approved by our insurance company. You also must be at least 19 or 20 and submit your license to us prior to being hired for the insurance company to use it to check your driving record. If you are 15, laws prohibit you from using certain machines and food service utensils and from entering walk-in coolers and freezers. No-one under the age of 18 is permitted to operate lawn mowing equipment. Due to our driving age and the need to drive, maintenance staff will be required to be 19 and be approved by our insurance company. Preferably, A/V personnel will be required to drive.
